2. Institution:

Laboratory of Bioanalytical Chemistry, Inorganic and Analytical Chemistry Group, Department of Chemistry, Faculty of Science, Kyushu University

3. Research Fields and Topics:

Field of expertise:

Chemical biology, Bioanalytical chemistry, Biophysics.

Research topics:

Chemical biology, analytical chemistry, and biophysics research associated with lipid membranes and membrane proteins. The final candidate is supposed to join the “Laboratory of Bioanalytical Chemistry” supervised by Prof. Nobuaki Matsumori.

Keywords of the specialized field:

Lipid membranes, Membrane proteins, Lipid rafts, Anesthetics, Lipidomics, Interaction analysis, Chemical library screening, Microscopy, NMR.

4. Educational and Other Duties:

The new associate professor hired with this position is requested to give lectures and demonstrations on some of the following courses: Analytical Chemistry for graduate and undergraduate students, Basic Experimental Procedure and Laboratory Chemistry Experiments in Analytical Chemistry for the undergraduate students, etc. It must be also noted that all professors including those in associate professor positions must be in charge of part of the administrative tasks to manage and operate this department.

5. Qualifications:

Applicants must have a Ph.D. degree.

6. Date of Appointment:

At the earliest possible date after the hiring decision is made.

7. Employment Conditions:

- Employment duration: Full time. The term of contract is up to the mandatory retirement age of Kyushu University.
- Probationary period: A three-month probationary period.
- Workplace: Faculty of Science, Kyushu University (744 Motoooka, Nishi-ku, Fukuoka, Japan)
- Working Hours: Based on the Discretionary Labor System for Professional Work, and subject to the employee's consent, Kyushu University allows the employee to perform his/her duties at his/her own discretion with respect to the means and allocation of time for carrying out the work, and to be deemed as having worked the prescribed number of working hours (7 hours and 45 minutes per day), regardless of the actual hours worked.
- Holidays: Saturdays, Sundays, national holidays, and December 29–January 3.
- Salary: Salary shall be paid in accordance with the Annual Salary System (issued April 1, 2020). The annual salary is determined by relevant rules of the university and composed from base salary depending on age and experience, performance bonus, and various allowance.
- Social Insurance: The health insurance, pension insurance, mutual retirement pension programs of Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology Mutual Society, and employment insurance of Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare.

10. Application Procedures:

Primary screening through application documents, followed by secondary examination through an interview (including an oral presentation).
