Faculty Position Announcement

1. Position: faculty member at Assistant Professor (tenure track) position
2. Employment Period
Assistant professor; Full-time (5-year term(*)). A review will be conducted in the fifth year, and if approved, the position will be converted to full-time (no term of office).
(*) If the period of continuous employment at the University exceeds five years, until the total period of employment exceeds ten years.
3. Division: Center for Ocean Plastic Studies (COPS) in Research Institute for Applied Mechanics (RIAM)
4. Place of employment: The place of employment will be either the Chikushi Campus of Kyushu University, Japan
5. Research field and principal duties:
The successful candidate will join the Field-Driven Research Unit and will engage in field-observation-based research on ocean plastics in collaboration with faculty members affiliated with COPS. We particularly encourage applicants who can contribute to advancing research in any of the following areas within interdisciplinary research projects: the chemical characterization, transformation processes, environmental fate, or environmental behavior of microplastics and associated contaminants.
The successful candidate will be expected to teach courses in the Interdisciplinary Graduate School of Engineering Sciences (IGSES), Kyushu University.
6. Qualifications: Applicants must have a doctoral degree at the time of appointment. Postdoctoral experience is desirable but is not required. Strong written and verbal communication skills in English are required.
7. Start date: As soon as possible on or after April 1, 2027 (If an earlier appointment becomes possible at Kyushu University, the start date may be moved forward in coordination with the selected candidate.)
8. Working conditions
 - 1) Salary
Annual salary (introduced in April 2020)
The annual salary will be determined in accordance with the regulations of Kyushu University based on experience.
 - 2) Working hours, break and overtime work
Based on the agreed-upon discretionary labor system for professional work, it is regarded that working hours are 7 hours and 45 minutes irrespective of how much time the employee actually spends on his/her works.
 - 3) Holidays
In addition to annual leave, Saturdays, Sundays, national holidays and the period from the 29th of December to the 3rd of January.
 - 4) Insurance
Employment insurance, industrial accident compensation insurance, health insurance and employees' pension insurance.

9. Application documents: Please submit items (1) to (7) online only. Submissions by postal mail will not be accepted. Refer to item (11) for submission instructions.
- 1) Resume (must include photo, current address, contact information (phone no. and email), academic background, professional work experience, awards and achievements, and research activities in academic societies)
 - 2) List of works (Papers (peer-reviewed and non-peer reviewed should be listed separately; includes those in press and accepted), Reviews, Books, Patents, Others)
 - 3) PDF files of representative papers (up to 5)
 - 4) Summary of past research achievements (classify by major research themes; an explanation by showing related papers. If there are citations, evaluations or use of other papers related to the achievements, a brief statement can be added)
 - 5) Other achievements, list of funds/grants received (must be sorted by the applicant's role as principal investigator or a collaborative investigator), and achievements of joint research (if any)
 - 6) A statement of future research plan and motivation (not to exceed 5 pages)
 - 7) 2 professional reference persons: name and contact information

Applicants may be asked to submit additional documents and asked for an interview online during the screening process.

10. Application deadline: All documents must be submitted by 17:00 JST on September 30, 2026.
